Over the years, the William B. Steele Award has evolved and taken several different forms - an essay contest, a poster contest, and now the award is taking another new form.

Beginning with the September, 2005 meeting and continuing at each monthly meeting of the MSS, the William B. Steele Award will provide a stipend of \$50 for the interesting case presentation. In order for the SDMS to grant us 2 CME credits for each meeting, we must have an interesting case presentation, in addition the featured speaker of the evening.

Anyone who is interested in presenting an interesting case must email the Secretary, Jeanne Beck at beckje@hfhs.org no later than midnight of the Wednesday preceding the MSS meeting (one week prior to the MSS meeting.) Please include your name and a contact number or email address, as well as the subject of your interesting case. Only one case will be presented at each meeting. If more than one person is presenting the chosen case, the \$50 stipend will be divided among each of the presenters. You will be notified if your case is chosen for presentation.

This is a wonderful opportunity for you to share interesting cases that you are seeing at your clinical sites and receive a monetary award as well. We are expecting a great participation in the new format of the William B Steele Award, so please email your intention to participate as early as possible for consideration each month.
